TITLE: BLESS YOU!

PRIMARY EDUCATION, 2ND CYCLE, 2ND YEAR.

SESSION 1.

SUBJECT: SCIENCE.

CENTRE OF INTEREST: ILLNESSES AND PARTS OF THE BODY.

AIM:

- To identify and practice the vocabulary related to illnesses.

CONTENTS:

- Vocabulary: illnesses (pain, flu, cold, hay fever...)
- Structures: How are you today? I'm ok. I have a pain in my knee.
- Phonetics: intonation in questions.

ASSESSMENT:

- Evidence for assessment: Direct observation by the teacher asking questions throughout the session.
- Assessment criteria: to be able to identify and practice the vocabulary related to illnesses.

OUTLINE OF ACTIVITIES: Brainstorming and go on showing Flash cards of different illnesses.

And then continue with the brainstorming. Carry on with the brainstorming asking them: when your temperature is high you have... After brainstorming, introduction of the different illnesses. (Flash Cards)	Board. Flash Cards. Traffic Lights: green, orange & red.
Plenary	BIG GROUP	10' – 15'	(NO WRITTEN) How are you? Give them different flashcards and they say how they feel.
